

Regulations and technical characteristics PASSION 2 RIDE

(text valid for participants of other than Italian nationality only)

DEFINITIONS

"Escort" means the person who escorts the Participant to the Course without taking part thereto.

"Bicycles" means the bicycles owned by the Participants or by Campagnolo, which the latter will put exclusively at the disposal of the Participants attending the Course for and not longer than the duration of the Course itself.

"Campagnolo" means Campagnolo Srl., a company with registered offices at Via della Chimica no. 4, 36100 - Vicenza, Italy.

"Participation Agreement" means the agreement executed between the Participant and Campagnolo at the time of payment of the Course and ruled by these Regulations.

"Course" or "P2R" means the theoretic and practical riding course called Passion 2 Ride, which can be subdivided into different difficulty classes.

"Instructors" means the instructors of the Course.

"Participant" means the person who participates to the Course.

"Participation Quota" means the value of the Course.

"Organizers" means Campagnolo and the other persons and corporate entities who organise and perform the Courses.

"Regulations" means these Regulations ruling participations to the Course.

"Website" means the website www.passion2ride.com.

1. CHARACTERISTICS OF THE COURSE

The Course will last 2 days and commence on Wednesday evening (dinner) and end on Friday evening (dinner and distribution of diplomas).

The Organizers may program further activities different from the Course starting from Saturday, to which the Participants may freely attend.

The Course consists of theoretical and practical lessons relating to bicycle riding techniques.

The Course is held in Italian and for foreigners in English.

Foreseeable dates: 17-18 May, 14-15 June, 28-29 June.

Place: Cesenatico, Feltre, Corvara.

The contents and the methods of performance of the Course are exclusively those indicated in these Regulations.

2. REGISTRATION

The Participants must have attained the age of 18 years at the time of the Course.

The Participants must be in good physical conditions at the time of the Course, attested by a medical certificate issued pursuant to Ministerial Decree 18.2.1982 stating the person's fitness to perform such agonistic activity - or, exclusively for the participants registered to the base level, issued pursuant to Ministerial Decree 28.02.1983 attesting the "good health" of the participant - which must be furnished to the Organizers before commencement of the Course. In case such conditions are not met, the Organizers may suspend and even exclude the Participants from the Course.

Furthermore, the Participants must, twenty-four hours before the Course, not have taken drugs and/or psychotropic drugs and/or medicines as well as no alcoholic drinks above the limits allowed by the Code on Rules of the Road.

It is possible to purchase the Course exclusively through the website up to 5 working days before the date of commencement of the Course, save in case that it is fully booked. At the time of purchase the Participant will have to fully pay the cost thereof through credit card.

The standard Participation price is equal to € 650 (VAT excluded) for 1 Participant with booking in a double bedroom. Other offers pack are foreseen for escorts or accommodation in single rooms.

The Participation price includes:

- 4 nights in a 4 star Hotel full board from Wednesday evening to Sunday morning, lunch and dinner drinks as well as the welcome dinner included;
- participation to the first "Gran Fondo" following the performance of the Course (GF Nove Colli, GF Campagnolo or Marathon Race dles Dolomites);
- daily excursions with Michele Bartoli and his staff.

- Campagnolo's technical and mechanical check of the bicycles, gift pack, technical material, diploma, photos;

Should a Participant not be able to attend the P2R, in case of accident or force majeure, he/she will have to give notice in writing to the Organizers by registered letter ten days before commencement of the Course. In such an event the Participant will be entitled to reimbursement of 70% (seventy per cent) of the amount. In case of failure or untimely cancellation the Participant will not be entitled to any reimbursement.

3. RULES ON BEHAVIOUR

It is the duty of all Participants to strictly adhere to the Code on Rules of the Road and not to behave in an unsafe or potentially dangerous manner for his/her safety, the safety of other Participants and of all the persons participating to the Course.

During the trial tests the Participants must wear - at their cost and expense - a homologated crash helmet.

It is suggested that the Participants bring with them changing clothes and a rain jacket in case of bad weather.

The Participants will have to diligently take care of the Bicycles and other material given to them by the Organizers and not allow other persons to use it, including the other Participants, unless otherwise expressly authorised by the Organizers.

The Participants will have to strictly adhere to the instructions and indications given by the Organizers and their staff or in any case by persons indicated by the Organizers with regard to, for example, route, speed, and any other necessary indication given by the Organizers, their personnel or any other person indicated by them.

4. SUBSTITUTES AND ESCORTS

The Participants cannot change the date originally chosen at the time of purchase of the Course with another date. Moreover, the Participants can cede to a third party the Participation Agreement. In such an event, the third party will have to arrive at the Course with a proxy duly signed by the substituted Participant. The third party may participate to the Course in substitution of the Participant provided all requested requisites are met (article 2) and fully accepted in writing the conditions imposed by these Regulations. It will be the duty of the Participant make the third party aware of the contents of these Regulations and to furnish the Organizers a copy of these Regulations duly signed by the third party.

Each Participant can be accompanied to the Course by an Escort who has previously paid the price foreseen for the latter. The participation of further Escorts may be agreed between the Participant and the Organizers via e-mail or telephone. In case of withdrawal by the Escort the conditions provided for in article 2 paragraph 7 for the Participant will apply.

5. LIABILITY

The Organizers will not be liable in any manner whatsoever for possible accidents, injury or damage indirectly suffered by the Participants and/or the Escorts, as well as animals and/or belongings of these latter during or after the Course, nor possible indirect injury or damage caused by Participants and/or the Escorts to third parties, animals or belongings.

The Organizers will not be liable for the custody of the Participants and/or Escorts' belongings.

Each Participant will be liable towards Campagnolo and the other Organizers for any damage which may derive to Campagnolo, to the other Organizers and/or other Participants as a consequence of violation by the Participant and/or its Escort, of the obligations provided for in these Regulations.

6. CANCELLATION, AMENDMENT OF THE DATE AND SUSPENSION OF THE COURSE BY THE ORGANIZERS

Campagnolo may, at its sole discretion, cancel, suspend or postpone the date of the Course should it not be held due to unsafe conditions or for force majeure causes or accidents.

The Organizers will promptly notify the suspension or postponement of the Course to the Participants via e-mail to the address indicated by the Participants at the time of purchase of the Course.

In case of postponement of the Course, the Participant will be entitled to withdraw from the Participation Agreement by sending a telefax within one day following receipt of said notice to the following number: 0444 225 400 or via e-mail to the following address: p2r@campagnolo.com.

The practical test of the Course will be held also in case of rainy weather, save for the necessary safety conditions.

7. ASSIGNMENT OF IMAGE RIGHTS

The Participants accept to assign to Campagnolo all rights to the use of their image during the Course alone and/or together with other images and/or their personal data, without any limit with regard to place, use, time and means and for the promotion of the Campagnolo products, the Course and Campagnolo in general, among which the diffusion of the Participant's image on the websites www.campagnolo.com and www.passion2ride.com, in the newspaper and magazines and in general through any other form or means of communication and to waive as from now to claim or make any demand, also of a financial type, against Campagnolo for the assignment of such right and in any case for such use of his/her image.

10. COMPETENT JURISDICTION

Any controversy which may arise between the Participants, Escorts, Campagnolo and other organizers will be submitted to the sole venue of the Courts of Vicenza, Italy.
